Purpose of report:

To submit a report regarding the application to renew an existing restriction on access to Essenhout and Juniper Drives, Dowerglen Extension 4.

Discussion:

An application has been received from Mr K Cross on behalf of Dower Estate Homeowners Association to renew the existing restriction of access for a period of five (5) years to Essenhout and Juniper Drives, Dowerglen Extension 4 as indicated on **Annexure "A"**. Detailed plans are attached as **Annexures "A1" to "A2"**.

The application was approved by the Executive Director: Corporate and Legal Services in principle on 28 May 2003 provided that the terms of Section 44 of the Act are met.

In terms of Section 45 (2) of the Act, the following role-players i.e. the applicant, the persons affected by the restriction, the South African Police Service and Council should discuss the application with the view to formulating appropriate conditions. In view of this prerequisite, comments from the South African Police Service are contained in the report as **Annexure "B"**. Attached as **Annexure "C"** is the motivation received from the applicant.

The Department of Roads, Transport and Civil Works is of the opinion that the renewal should only be approved for 2 years. It should be pointed out that the proposed technical guidelines referred to by the said Department, refers to traffic impact studies to be undertaken. No complaints and/or problems were experienced during the 2 year period and it is recommended that the application be approved for 5 years.

Comments by the Department of Roads, Transport and Civil Works:

"The application is not in order as far as this department is concerned. The renewal period of five years is not acceptable. The Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality is in the process of adopting new technical guidelines for the restriction of access areas. This department will only support a maximum extension period of two (2) years."

Comments by the Department of Municipal Infrastructure:

ITEM .../2003

"No objection, 24hr access is a prerequisite."

Comments by the Department of Development Planning:

In terms of the legislation, approval for access control can only be granted for a maximum of two years at a time after which a new application has to be submitted for a further two years. Hence, we cannot support the application for a five-year period until 2008. We would however support a renewal of the access control for a further two-year period from the date of expiry of the previous two year period."

Comments by Public Safety (Emergency Service):

"No objection."

Comments by the Department of Public Safety:

"No objection, no previous complaints were received during the period of the original closure."

Comments by the Department of Health and Social Welfare:

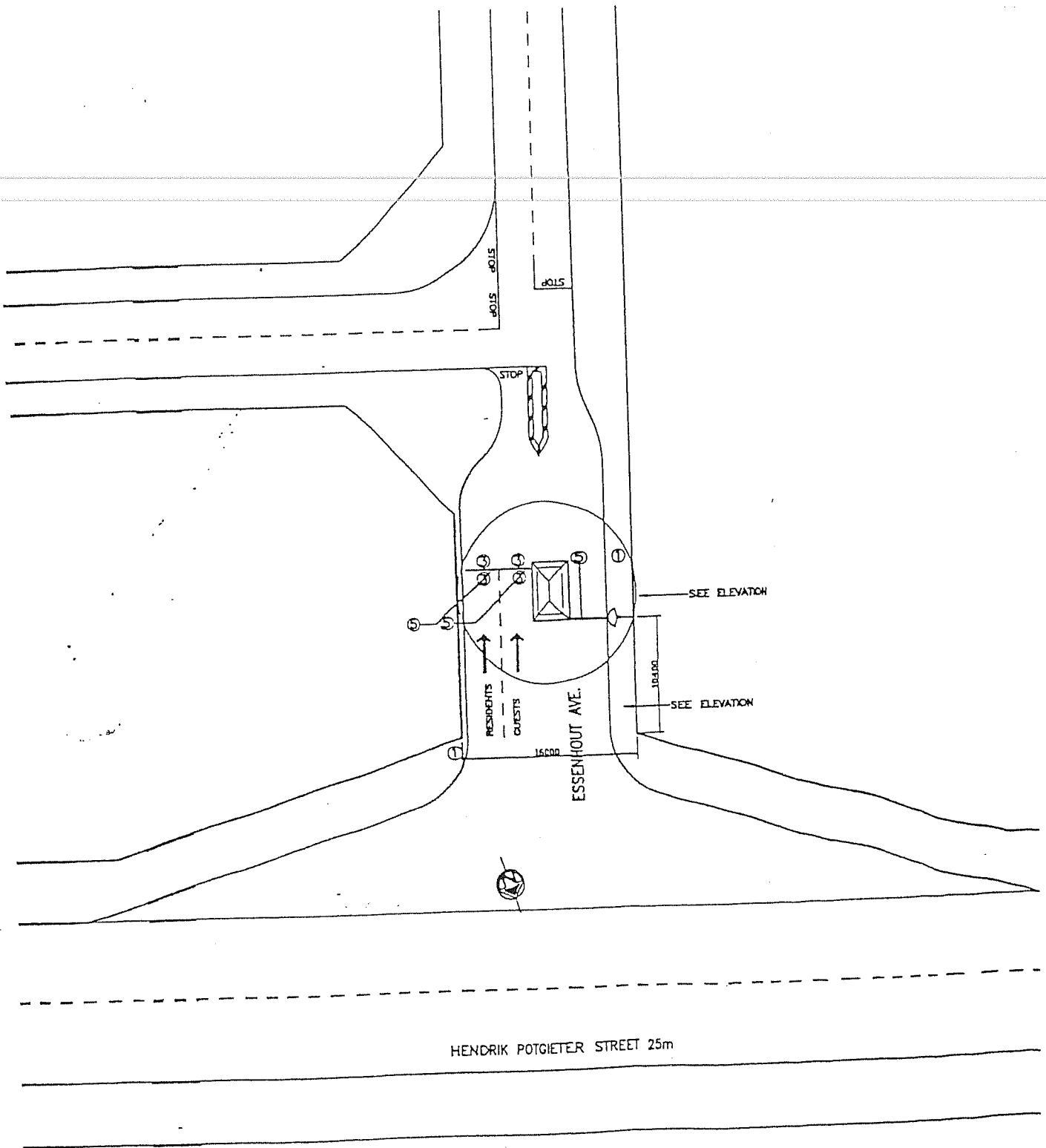

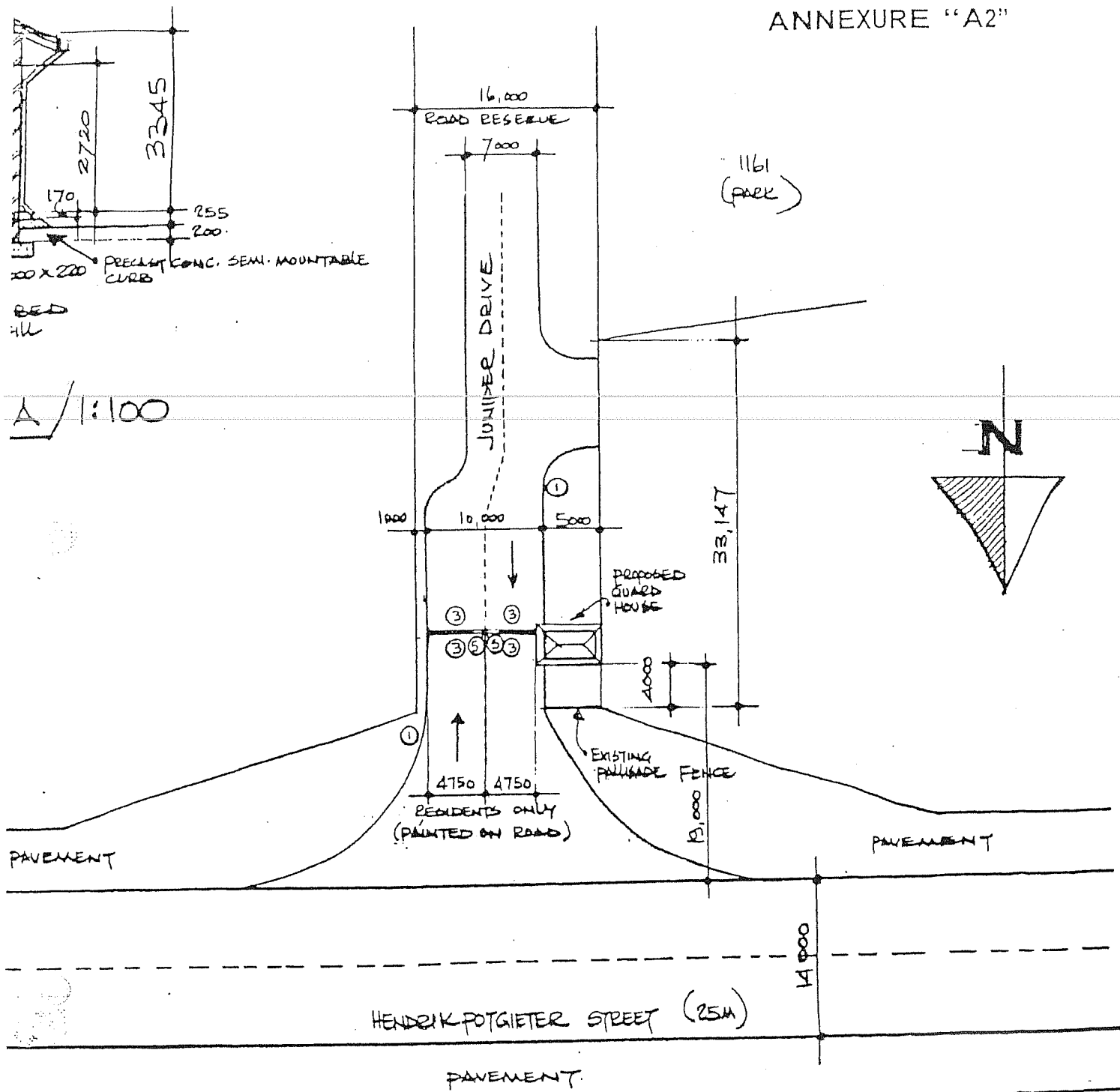

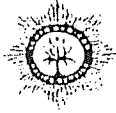

DOWERGLEN EXT. 4 ROAD CLOSURE

1. A reasonable period of time has elapsed since the establishment of this road closure and the SAPS has been monitoring this closure from the start.
2. The overall result has been a marked reduction in the number of incidents of a serious nature. Here I refer specifically to the priority crimes namely :
 - 2.1 Housebreaking and Theft.
 - 2.2 Theft of Motor vehicles.
 - 2.3 Armed Robbery of Motor Vehicles.

All of the above crimes involve motor vehicles as the primary target or use motor vehicles for the execution. It therefor stands to reason that a restriction and monitoring of vehicles will continue significantly to the reduction of priority crimes.
3. The SAPS fully support the renewal of the Dowerglen ext. 4 application.

2. DESCRIPTION OF THE PUBLIC PLACE, WHICH IS THE SUBJECT OF
THE APPLICATION (- see attached road plan)

Which is the subject for application of renewal includes Dowerglen ext. 4
between Hendrick Pogieter, Elm Street, Linksfield road, Edenvale High
School and Norman House forming the Eastern boundaries. The roads
within the closure are Juniper Drive, Waxberry Street, Amandel Avenue,
Essenhout Drive, Baobab Street and Kershout Crescent. The residential
complexes and freestanding homes effected are those with direct and
indirect access to the afore mentioned roads.

3. DESCRIPTION OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES GIVING RISE TO THE
APPLICATION

Therefore, reasons for requesting restriction of access with further
application for reviewing to 2007 are:

1. Incidents of violent crime with respect to high-jacking, molestation
of residents, staff and housebreakings have decreased to zero as a
direct result of this restriction of access as can be seen by the
number of acceptance letter received from the residents at
Dowerglen ext. 4. The owners are definitely in favour and support
and request this renewal.
2. The aesthetics of Dowerglen ext. 4 area has benefited from this
closure.

3. Residents are able to freely and with comfort and security move through their area.
4. Builders, garden services and other members of the residential service industry with clients in Dowerglen ext. 4 feel that the closure makes their work easier as the result of the inherent safety benefits resulting from the closure.

4. CATEGORY AND ESTIMATED NUMBER OF PERSONS AFFECTED BY THE CIRCUMSTANCES GIVING RISE TO THE APPLICATION

1. Residents: On an average of +- 3 persons per households including dependents = 191 homes = +-573 residents.

As per the received acceptance letters: 286 = 83,63%

All approve, no disapprovals, those who abstained from signing were not available to sign.

2. Visitors: +- 400 people per day including weekends. (Average taken over a seven day period).

3. Service visitors: Council services — once per week
Meter readers — once per month
Refuse Removal — once per week
Maintenance & building — +- four per day

5. NATURE AND EXTENT OF THE RESTRICTION IN RESPECT OF WHICH THE APPLICATION IS SOUGHT

Description:

1. Essenhout Avenue

- 1.1 Guardhouse, brick under tile with ablution facilities.
Guardhouse is situated at eh intersection of Essenhout and Hendrick Potgieter in center of Essenhout. Access is controlled by electronically governed booms.

Entrance: residents boom
Visitors boom congruous with guardhouse

Exit: One boom with drop box for visitors, electronic disks and swipe-pad for residents

2. Juniper Drive

2.1 Residents only. Entrance and exit booms electronically controlled (swipe-pad for residential disk holders). Juniper Drive is open 24 hours for residents with disks, i.e. those subscribing by paying the agreed levy.

2.2 Guardhouse is under construction (approval granted by council). The guardhouse will be situated in Juniper Drive near the intersection of Hendrick Potgieter and Juniper Drive congruous with the Eastern boundary of Elmwood sectional title complex.

6. CATEGORY AND AN ESTIMATED NUMBER OF PERSONS WHO MAY BE AFFECTED BY THE RESTRICTION IN RESPECT OF WHICH THE APPLICATION IS SOUGHT

ANNEXURE "E"

A. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. The applicants must commit themselves either to the formation of a Residents Association or register a Section 21 Company upon approval of the application.
2. The applicants should be informed that if any gates or booms are erected it would be for their own cost and if the application is not renewed after the specified five-year period the gate or boom will have to be removed at their cost. Maintaining these booms or gates will be the responsibility of the applicant.
3. Access to arterial roads, major access roads or public transport routes as determined by Council may not be restricted.
4. The boom/gate shall be manned on a 24-hour basis to enable access for emergency/maintenance and refuse removal personnel of the Council at all times. The Council should be indemnified in the event of any claims arising as a result of emergency and other vehicles being delayed as a result of the restriction.
5. The required road information signs approved by the Department of Roads, Transport and Civil Works should be erected/installed.
6. Access to booms/gates (entrance gates) to be a minimum of 5.5 metres wide. Building plans must be submitted for approval.
7. No major disruption of traffic patterns and movements should be caused by the restriction nor will unduly long travel distances be caused to the residents of the area or the general public as a result of same.
8. Renewal of restriction of access will be approved for a period of five years only and the Council may extend the duration if the applicant initiates the procedure for the extension one month prior to the expiry date of the initial approval.
9. The Council reserves the right to withdraw the permission granted to impose restriction of access at any time should any of the conditions not be complied with.
10. An approved access restriction arrangement in an area will be in terms of a formal agreement signed

between the Council and the authorised Section 21 Company or the Residents Association.

11. The Council reserves the right to cancel the agreement at any time if the applicant does not comply with all the conditions.
12. The restriction of access must be conducted in such a way to control the traffic to the restricted area rather than to prohibit vehicles to enter the area.
13. ~~Access to public open spaces (parks etc) and community facilities may not be restricted in any way.~~
14. Mail delivery should be arranged with the Post Office.
15. Meter readings should be arranged with the Department of Finance.
16. Minutes of meetings of the Section 21 Company/Residents Association must be made available to the Council.
17. No expectations of any future rights shall be created and/or assumed.

B. NATURE OF PHYSICAL CLOSURE

1. The physical closure of the road after the receipt of the written approval from Council must be undertaken by the Section 21 Company or the Residents Association at their cost. No assistance of any kind in the form of financing, material, labour or equipment will be provided by the Council.
2. If the physical structure is not of a temporary nature it can be removed by Council at the cost of the applicant at the end of the five-year period if the application is not renewed or is refused by Council. An acceptable bank guarantee should be provided to the Municipality.
3. With the erection of the physical structure the Council's services and other assets should not be interrupted or interfered with.
4. Any removal, relaying or protection of municipal services will be to the satisfaction of the Departments of Roads, Transport and Civil Works and Municipal Infrastructure at the cost of the applicant.

5. Storm-water runoff within road reserves must be accepted and servitudes must be observed and accommodated without affecting any other service.
 6. The physical structure, guard huts, lighting, signage, etc. must be maintained by the Section 21 Company or the Residents Association at their cost.
 7. Prior to the erection of any physical structure a Site Development Plan must be submitted and approved by the Council. The plan should indicate at least the following:
-

- 7.1 The exact location of the physical structure.
- 7.2 The location and dimensions of information signage.
- 7.3 The location and dimensions of guard huts and/or chemical toilet facilities.
- 7.4 The width of the access.
- 7.5 The location of Council services such as water, sewer, electricity and storm-water catch pits.
- 7.6 The distance from the intersection to the physical structure.
